However, we have to assume that at some point students will have to complete some sort of assessment or exam on this content and therefore should continue to follow this programme of study despite the current advice on summer exams.

Year 10 Maths

Students should complete every PowerPoint slide created by Miss Bakhshzaad and Miss Miah uploaded onto the Google Drive and the corresponding work accompanied to this.

Year 11 Maths

Students must complete their mistakes from paper 1 and 2. Students should identify 3 – 4 topics from the papers to revise and complete it for the week. They can refer to the CGP workbook or relevant websites: CorbettMaths or MathsMadeEasy. Suggested topics based on revision in class this week are: Bearings, Constructions, Cumulative Frequency and Interquartile Range.

The individual information for each class is as follows:

Year 10 Chemistry (Jupiter)

Students should be using the Year 11 Revision Folder in order to help students go over the material they have already learned as well as content that they will be learning up until their GCSEs next year. There are exampro revision packs with the names of the Chapters that we have covered thus far (Atomic Structure, Bonding, Quantitative Chemistry and Chemical Changes) which students should use to revise along. There are also Past Papers. As we are nearly done teaching Paper 1, students should be able to access most of these papers and use them for further revision. Summary and Practise questions for topics C1 to C6 in the Kerboodle Textbook as well as online resources for the same topics on BBC Bitesize would allow for further revision opportunities.
