

SSWL Remote Education Assessment Procedures

During the current lockdown all students will continue to be assessed to help them stay on track and make progress.

For each virtual lesson the student will be graded 1-4 for their effort in lessons. These grades are recorded on the School management system and are available for mentors to see and communicate with parents.

During lessons students will get verbal feedback to answers they contribute.

Students will also be sent mark schemes to self assess pieces of work they have completed so they can ask for targeted assistance.

Students will get written feedback in the following ways; comments on shared Google documents, emails or annotations on submitted work.

Assessments on topics covered will still go ahead, this maybe through Google Forms, emailed test papers or shared documents. These will be graded in the normal way.

For year 11 and 13 some of these pieces of work will be submitted for moderation across the Trust. We will do this on at least 3 occasions to gather evidence that will help inform the grade that we submit to the examination boards later in the year.
